IMPORTANT NOTES * Membership requirements In dealing with the Society's registry, there are several aspects of membership to be understood.

- All transferors & transferees of Pure Bred Arabian Mares & Stallions (fillies & colts) must be current financial members of the Society. This is not mandatory in the case of transfers involving geldings of all categories, as well as Part Bred Arabian, Anglo Arabians, Arabian Ponies & Arabian Warmbloods. Owners of Arabian Bred Stallions must be members of the Society.

However, there are two scales of fees:

- one for current financial members of the Society.
- a higher scale for non members.
- To obtain the member scale of fees on transfer the person(s) lodging payment for transfer (vendor or purchaser) must be a current financial member of the Society.
- See reverse for more details.

Where owners or previous owners consist of more than one person, then all persons must sign application unless a form of authority for one person to sign (either solely or alternatively) is lodged with the Society. (MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORMS & AUTHORITY FORMS ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE SOCIETY).

MEMBERSHIP: In dealing with the Society's Registry, there are several aspect of membership to be understood.

- NEW OWNERS AS WELL AS VENDORS OF PUREBRED ARABIAN MARES & STALLIONS, COLTS, FILLIES & ARABIAN DERIVATIVE FULLY REGISTERED STALLIONS OR COLTS, MUST BE CURRENT FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF THE ARABIAN HORSE SOCIETY OF AUSTRALIA LIMITED.
- This is not mandatory in the case of transfers involving geldings of all categories as well as Part Bred Arabian, Anglo Arabian, Arabian Ponies & Arabian Warmbloods, Mares, Fillies or Foal recorded Colts.
- Owners of Arabian Bred Stallions to be used at stud must be members.
- However there are two (2) scales of fees applying:
 - one for current financial members of the Society
 - a higher scale for non members
- To obtain the members scale of fees on transfer, the person(s) lodging payment must be a current financial member of the Society.
- If, as the new owner, you are effecting the transfer you are not a member of the Society, yet wish to obtain the benefits of the member scale of fees on transactions, you will be required to lodge an application for membership, together with the require fee either before or at the same time you lodge the transfer application. Full membership fee is \$130.00.

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP FEES: For person under 18 years are \$56.00. This entitles the Junior member to member rates of fees for transactions with the Registry.

FULL NAMES: If only persons initials are supplied it is often not clear who the parties to a transfer are. It is common for several members of a family to own one horse and yet other members to own another horse, and so on. Thus we need full names to fully identify parties.

JOINT OWNERSHIP/NEW OWNERS: HORSES MAY BE JOINTLY OWNED AS (a) JOINT TENANTS IN WHICH CASE, ON THE DEATH OF ONE OWNER THE REMAINING OWNER/S AUTOMATICALLY ACQUIRE OWNER'S SHARE OR (b) TENANTS IN COMMON, IN WHICH CASE IT PASSES BY HIS/HER WILL.

AUTHORITIES TO SIGN: Where owners comprise more than one person, either all such persons must sign the application or lodge with the Society a special form giving authority for one person to sign on behalf of all the owners. (It is allowable for a number of persons to each sign alone as alternative signatories). This form (of authority) is obtainable from the Society's office and there is no charge for lodgement of it. The requirement is applicable to the previous owner, as well as the new owner.

REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE: You would appreciate that WE REQUIRE THE ORIGINAL REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE to enable details of the new owner to be recorded on it.

If this certificate has been altered or written on by any person other than the Society's Registry staff, or is torn or mutilated, a new certificate must be prepared. If this is necessary, a fee to provide a duplicate certificate has to be paid.

IF A CERTIFICATE IS LOST, a letter from the last registered owner must be provided to the Society stating the facts of the loss and quoting the name of the horse involved. Again, a fee to replace the certificate is payable. This is presently \$30.00.

PEDIGREE: It is also a requirement that vendors provide the purchase with a clearly written or typed 4 generation pedigree of the registered horse transferred.

DATE OF TRANSFER: Vendors & Purchasers have the option to negotiate the date of transfer as it is recognised that a time payment arrangement may have to be concluded before legal transfer of ownership can occur. This should be borne in mind when placing the date of transfer on the application. Be careful! If a transfer date, once placed on the application is altered in anyway, then the initials of vendors and purchasers must be made against the alteration. If this is not done, then the next highest fee on the schedule will automatically apply. The actual date of purchase is also of utmost importance for mares and stallions to avert later complications in breeding records and progeny registration.

ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS: All the information and necessary signatures must be properly placed on this application. If this is not done, or if the correct fee and registration certificate do not accompany the application, all papers will be returned to the new owner(s) for attention and action. A penalty fee of \$20.00 will apply.

The Society has adopted the practice of returning incomplete or incorrect applications to new owners, as this has been found to be in the best interests of new owners, even though the fault may lie with the previous owners.

FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IF THE PURCHASERS SECTION HAS BEEN ALTERED BY DELETION.

TRANSFER BEFORE REGISTRATION: In a case where a horse is transferred before it has been registered, new owners must understand that the application for transfer will only be dealt with after the breeders application for registration has been accepted and finalised. If a registration application requires attention, this is also usually returned to the new owner, with a listing of matters requiring attention.

REGULATIONS: There are many requirements to be met, all of which have the aim of protecting as far as possible, the interests of all involved with Arabian Horses. These requirements are embodied in the Society's regulations. Copies of regulations are available free of charge from the Society's office.

DECEASED ESTATES: THERE ARE A NUMBER OF SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS TO BE MET WHEN TRANSFER OCCURS, BECAUSE OF THE DEATH OF AN OWNER. PLEASE WRITE OR PHONE THE SOCIETY FOR INFORMATION ON THESE REQUIREMENTS BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH A TRANSFER.
