The AHSA Youth Exchange

1. The Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd shall award a trip to New Zealand for 10 days to a person 18-25 years of age inclusive as at 31st January 2010, in recognition of their service and contribution to the Arabian breed in Australia.
2. The New Zealand Arab Horse Breeders Society (Inc) shall in turn reciprocate and offer the same opportunity.
3. The AHSA and The NZAHBS shall pay a return airfare and any additional internal travel expenses and/or accommodation necessary within each country to the value of \$400. Details of these expenses shall be provided for reimbursement. All other expenses shall be borne by the exchange student.
4. The AHSA and The NZAHBS shall organise host families throughout the duration of the trip to accommodate the exchange students and shall avail them opportunities of attending Arabian events, offering instruction and experience as well as some recreational time. Both Societies will, to the best of their ability, carefully select host families to try and cater for the student's interests.
5. The Applicants for this exchange will provide to the AHSA Ltd no later than 31st January 2010:
 - a. A current photo of themselves
 - b. A completed nomination form detailing the involvement and contribution they have made to the Arabian breed. This may include breed promotion through competition or otherwise, voluntary service as a member or committee person to a youth group or Arabian affiliate, or any other contribution they have provided – eg instructing, stewarding, marshalling, pencilling, attending working bees etc
 - c. List special interests they have within the Arabian breed and their plans for future endeavours.
 - d. Applicants may be required to attend an interview with a State Director of the AHSA prior to selection.
6. The exact timing of the trip will be determined by the AHSA and the NZAHBS. Due consideration will be given to trying to incorporate major Arabian events in each country and during university/school holidays
7. Applicants must be a current member of the AHSA or current member of an AHSA affiliate.
8. The recipient of this exchange must be prepared to give a detailed report of their experience to the AHSA and the AHN on their return.
9. The recipient of this exchange will be determined by the Board of Directors of the AHSA and such decision shall be final.
10. The AHSA Ltd reserves the right not to make an award in any year that they feel the applicants have not reached a suitable standard.
11. It is hoped that the recipient of this exchange would in turn be prepared to help host/entertain future recipients from NZ.
12. Once an applicant has won the Exchange, they are ineligible to enter again.
