



STALLION BREEDING DOCUMENTS 2010 / 2011 TO ALL MEMBERS / BREEDERS 1/08/2010 – 31/07/2011

1. There is a \$15.00 notification fee which is non-refundable for each stallion or colt to be used for natural service for the 2010 / 2011 Season.
In addition there is an extra \$15.00 notification fee (non refundable) for each Stallion or Colt to be used for Artificial Insemination (A.I) in the 2010 / 2011 Season.
Members must specify whether their stallion is to be used for Natural Service, A.I. or both. Members contemplating A.I. service are advised to refer to the Society's Regulations for conditions of use or contact this office.
2. Service certificates will be available from the Society at a cost of \$20.00 each. (Please note that one service certificate is required for a mare being served by a stallion in the season, irrespective of how often she returns to service.)
New service certificates - if a mare is subsequently served by a **DIFFERENT STALLION**, a second service certificate is required.
e.g. To serve 3 mares:
 $\$15.00 \text{ notification} + 3 \times \$20.00 \text{ Service Certificate} = \75.00
A Service Certificate is required for every foal to be registered.
3. The stallion owner may order as many as necessary and extra service certificates are available from the Society at \$20.00 each **PAYABLE IN ADVANCE**.
4. A.I. Transported / Stored Service Certificates are available for \$20.00 each to be used when semen is transported, or has been stored and monthly reports (as supplied) must be forwarded to the Society. One is required for each mare to be inseminated.
The Mare Owner **MUST** nominate the mare for A.I. use and will be issued with the necessary paperwork. Please indicate name of stallion for A.I.
5. Service certificates not used will be refunded or can be used for the next breeding season. If a refund is required they must be returned in mint condition. Service certificates on which the stallion / mare details have been altered will not be accepted for the purpose of registration of foals.
6. Should duplicate certificates have to be issued for **any reason whatsoever**, the following must be complied with:
 - i) If the Stallion Owner loses or destroys them accidentally he must bear the cost of the duplicate certificate (\$20).
 - ii) If the Mare Owner loses or destroys them accidentally, he must pay the Stallion Owner the \$20 for the duplicate.
7. **Maiden Purebred Colts have to be DNA tested at the Owner's expense and are not to be used until a completed result has been received from the Lab.**
8. No nomination fee is required for Stallions 25 years of age or older however they must still be nominated and service certificates must be completed.
9. **All Purebred Stallions must have a DNA result on record with the Society before they will be approved for Use At Stud.**
